Coast Live Oak (*Quercus agrifolia*)



Valley Oak (*Quercus lobata*)



Black Oak (*Quercus kelloggii*)



Blue Oak (*Quercus douglasii*)



Tanoak (*Notholithocarpus densiflorus*)



Garry or Oregon Oak (*Quercus garryana*)

Susceptible to Sudden Oak Death.

Coast live and black oak can die from infection but do not play a role in spreading the disease. Tanoak are easily killed by the pathogen and also spread disease.

Not Susceptible to Sudden Oak Death.

Valley, blue, and Garry oaks do not become infected with the *Phytophthora ramorum*, the SOD pathogen.
