

# 2017 4-H CHICKENQUE OPEN HOUSE & CHICKEN BBQ POSTER CONTEST

## TIMELINE

---

- February..... Begin work on posters! Include all of the information listed below!!!
- March..... Posters are judged at the club level. **ONE** winner in each age category goes on to county for judging. All Primary member posters go to county for recognition. Others entries may be placed in the community as a Chickenque promotion by youth for credit in their record book\*.
- April ..... Posters are judged at the April CCC meeting on April 4, 2017. Only one poster per age division per club will be judged! One winner and two runners up in each age division (with the exception of Primary Members) will be awarded and receive pins. All Primary Members will receive participation ribbons. Winning posters come to the 4-H office for display and then are displayed at the Chickenque event. Primary Member posters are returned at the end of the meeting so they can be placed in the community.

## AGE DIVISIONS

---

- Primary Members ..... Aged 8 and under – *Receive a participation ribbon*
- Junior..... 9 and 10 years old
- Intermediate..... 11 – 13 years old
- Senior ..... 14 – 19 years old
- Adult..... 19 and over – *Receive a special award, not a pin*
