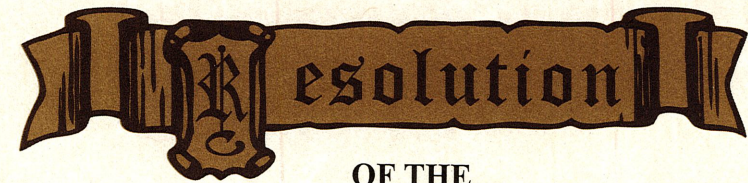

Whereas, the mission of 4-H is to engage youth in reaching their fullest potential while advancing the field of youth development; and


Whereas, 1,500 youth in the County of Sonoma are active annually in 4-H programs, and 325 adult volunteers contribute countless hours; and


Whereas, 4-H is deserving of public recognition for its distinguished record of helping young people become healthy, happy, and thriving citizens who make a positive difference in their communities.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims October 1-7, 2017 as National 4-H Week in Sonoma County.









